

CAMPGROUND FAQ'S

1: ACCESSIBILITY INTO CAMPGROUND

Can I come and go from the campground at night?

Yes...you can leave the campground. However, circuit access is strictly prohibited outside of gate opening times.

2: ALCOHOL

Is alcohol permitted?

Yes...alcohol is permitted in cans, casks, or plastic bottles. **Glass is not permitted.** Alcohol limits are subject to Liquor Licencing Permit conditions. Vehicles will be searched on entry to the campground and any prohibited items will be confiscated.

3: BBQ's

Are BBQs permitted?

Yes...BBQs are permitted in the campground but are subject to fire restrictions/total fire bans.

4: CAMPING SUPPLIES

Where is the camping store located?

At the Visitor Centre

What is available for purchase?

Basic items such as bread, milk, eggs and firewood.

What are the opening/closing times for the Store?

Thursday 9.00am-6.00pm – open for breakfast and lunch.

Friday-Sunday 7.00am-6.00pm – open for breakfast and lunch.

There will be a variety of pre-packed meals available for purchase for campers to reheat. (Microwaves will be available in the campground.)

5: FACILITIES

Are there any facilities and what are they?

Yes...there are showers and accessible toilets. Power is not available except on purchased powered camping sites.

6: FIRES

Are fires permitted?

Yes...small, contained fires can be lit in the campground but are subject to fire restrictions/total fire bans.

They cannot be placed under low hanging trees or branches and must be within a firebox. Holes cannot be dug to house a fire.

Fireboxes and firewood can be purchased from the Visitor Centre. A refundable deposit of \$50 is required for the firebox.

7: GENERAL INFORMATION

- No tent structures greater than 100m². – They must be secured properly.
- No marquees.
- Campervans, mobile homes, and caravans can park in the general camping area.
- There is a designated 'bikes only' camping area.
- You are allowed to sleep in your car in the general camping area.

- There are 31 5m x 10m powered sites available. These must be pre-purchased by booking online through Ticketek.
- Apart from powered sites, there are no other allocated sites – camping is on a first-come, first-served basis.

8: GENERATORS

Are generators allowed in the campground?

Yes...generators are allowed within the campground but **must not** be used within the hours of 10.00pm to 7.00am

9: LOCATION (CAMPGROUND)

Where is the campground located?

Access is by Gate 2. The camping area is located near turn 1 and turn 2 (subject to change in ground conditions).

Tickets and campground wristbands are available at Gate 2 accreditation upon arrival. If this is closed, proceed to the campground. Security and the Manager will allow access to the campground. (You will need to leave your driver's licence with security overnight.) Return to accreditation first thing in the morning to retrieve your licence and collect your wristbands.

10: LOCATION (TICKETING OFFICE)

Where is the Ticketing Office located?

Located at the Accreditation Office. Entry is by Gate 2 (approx. 100 metres west of the main Gate 1)

11. NOISE LEVELS

Out of respect for other campers, officials/track marshals, please be courteous and keep noise levels to a minimum between the hours of 10.00pm – 7.00am.

12: OPERATING TIMES (TICKET OFFICE)

What is the campground's ticketing office operating times?

Thursday	7.00am – 7.00pm
Friday	7.00am – 6.00pm
Saturday	7.00am – 6.00pm
Sunday	9.00am – 12.00pm

13: OPERATING TIMES (CAMPGROUND)

What is the campground's operating times?

Opens	Thursday	20.02.2025 @ 9.00am
Closes	Monday	24.02.2025 @ 12.00pm

14: PETS

Are pets allowed in the campground and on the circuit grounds?

No...pets are not allowed, with the exception of Certified Assistance dogs. Please, always carry your pet's certification with you.

15: QUIET/MOTORCYCLE AREAS

Will there be a quiet family area?

No.

Is there an area reserved for people travelling on motorcycles?

Yes...caravans and campervans are not allowed in the bike only area.

I am bringing a camper trailer and my friends are travelling by motorcycle; can we camp in the bike only area?

Yes...however the tow vehicle must be moved to the off-site carpark.
